Things to do

- 1 Sewerby Hall and Gardens**
A spectacular clifftop estate featuring a restored Grade I listed Georgian house, a small zoo housing Humboldt penguins and landscaped grounds overlooking Bridlington Bay.
- 2 Scarborough**
A vibrant seaside town offering a mix of Victorian charm, sandy beaches, fishing heritage and modern attractions including Peasholm Park.
- 3 Burton Agnes Hall**
A magnificent Elizabethan manor house filled with treasures collected over 4 centuries, set in award-winning gardens.
- 4 Bridlington Harbour Heritage Museum**
A small museum collection of nautical artefacts and photographs dedicated to the history of the harbour.
- 5 Bay Watersports**
A watersports provider offering coastal adventures, including coasteering, kayak tours, paddleboarding and sailing, with all equipment and tuition provided.
- 6 Woldgate Trekking Centre**
Treks on horseback through woodland and over the dales for riders of all ages and experiences.
- 7 Filey**
A low-key and traditional seaside resort famous for its tranquil atmosphere and Victorian-Edwardian charm. It features a glorious 5 mile stretch of golden sandy beach.
- 8 North York Moors National Park**
UK's largest expanse of heather moorland, lush wooded dales and rugged, Jurassic-era coastline with cliffs and secluded beaches.
- 9 York**
A picturesque, walled cathedral city with a rich 2,000 year history of Roman roots, Viking heritage and medieval charm. Famous for its pedestrianised cobblestone streets, Gothic architecture and museums.
- 10 Bridlington Spa**
An iconic entertainment venue on the seafront, featuring an ornate Edwardian theatre, an Art Deco Ballroom and seaview café bar.

Walk

Flamborough Head is a spectacular 8 mile long chalk headland with 400 feet cliffs, a lighthouse and the fabulous Dane's Dyke beach to the south, with striking white pebbles and rock pools, and North Landing to the north.
