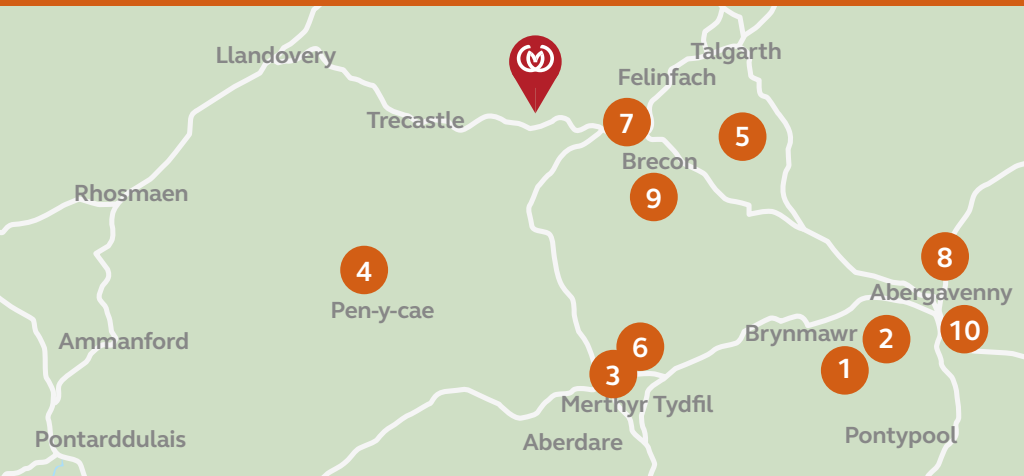

Things to do

- 1 Big Pit National Coal Museum**
A real coal mine and one of Britain's leading mining museums. The main attraction is the Underground Tour which sees visitors travel 300 feet down a mine shaft!
- 2 Blaenavon Ironworks**
A UNESCO World Heritage Site – an 18th Century industrial site, one of the largest and advanced iron producers, spearheading steam-powered blast furnaces.
- 3 Cyfarthfa Castle Museum and Art Gallery**
This regency mansion is the best-preserved Ironmaster's house in Wales, featuring social history, fine art and industrial exhibits.
- 4 National Showcaves of Wales**
Wales' top visitor attraction, Britain's Finest Natural Wonder and the most breathtaking showcaves in Northern Europe.
- 5 Llangorse Multi Activity Centre**
An award-winning adventure hub, with indoor and outdoor activities – real rock and artificial climbing walls, bouldering and indoor caving.
- 6 Brecon Mountain Railway**
Enjoy the beauty of the Brecon Beacons National Park by vintage steam train.
- 7 Brecon Canoe Club**
A welcoming sports club offering everything from white-water rafting, canoeing, paddleboarding and competitive canoe polo.
- 8 Crickhowell**
A vibrant market town in the Usk Valley. Famous for its award-winning High Street and historic 17th Century bridge, it is a popular base for walkers exploring the Black Mountains.
- 9 Brecon**
A picturesque market town renowned for Georgian architecture, cathedral and military heritage. Serving as a popular hub for outdoor activities exploring the surrounding mountains.
- 10 Abergavenny**
Known as the 'Gateway to Wales' this market town surrounded by the Black Mountains and Brecon Beacons, is celebrated for the landscapes and a thriving culinary scene including the annual Abergavenny Food Festival.

Walk

The Brecon Beacons National Park provides some of the finest walking areas in the country, from gentle strolls to tough mountain scrambles. A hike to the top of Pen-y-Fan will give you an enormous sense of achievement as well as spectacular views.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 8: The Taff Trail running from Penarth to Holyhead and part of the Celtic Trail East.
