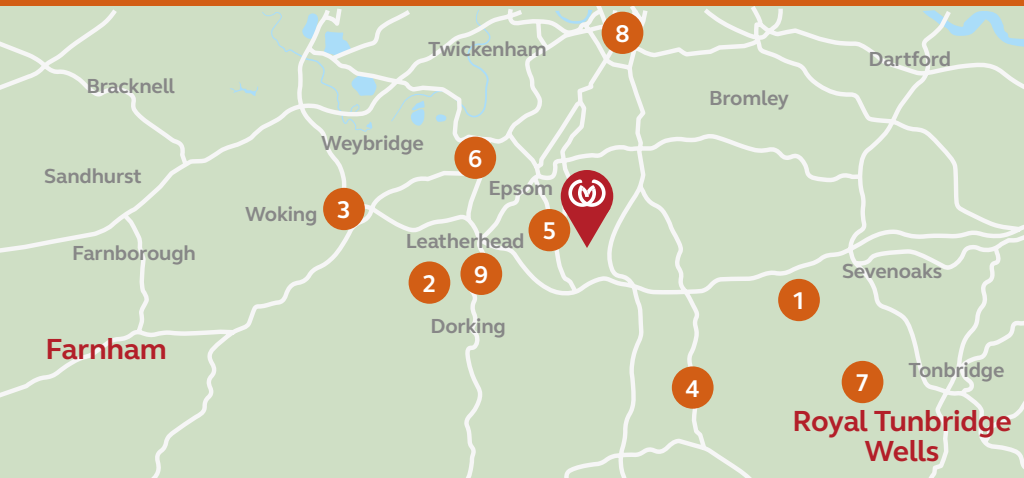

- 1 Chartwell House**
A sprawling country house, famous as the home of Sir Winston Churchill. The estate operates as a living museum, providing a look into his personal life, family and hobbies.
- 2 Polesden Lacey**
A stunning Edwardian country retreat known for its glittering interiors, expansive estate with wooded grounds and parklands, a walled rose garden, bird hide and sweeping views.
- 3 RHS Wisley**
The flagship garden of the Royal Horticultural Society. Wisley features spectacular glasshouses, plant collections and acts as a living laboratory for gardening innovation.
- 4 British Wildlife Centre**
A renowned conservation and education park housing the finest collection of native British species – the ideal place to observe up-close in natural habitats.
- 5 The Big Shoot – Reigate**
Everyone can enjoy the hilariously fun and competitive thrills of Clay Pigeon Shooting.
- 6 Chessington World of Adventures**
A theme park with over 40 rides, a massive zoo and a sealife centre, the resort provides an exciting family-friendly day out for all ages.
- 7 Royal Tunbridge Wells**
An affluent spa town famous for 17th Century elegant Georgian architecture. A popular commuter and cultural hub for history and garden lovers, with castles, country manors and one-of-a-kind shops.
- 8 London**
The bustling capital and largest city of England and UK. On the River Thames, just 30 minutes by train, this leading global powerhouse in finance, arts and culture is home to over 9 million residents.
- 9 Surrey Hills**
Covering a quarter of Surrey, this breathtaking 163 square-mile paradise is a National Landscape with rolling hills, woodlands and panoramic views.

Accessing the site

Site access restrictions:

- ✓ The access road to site from the bottom of Dean Lane (by Starbucks) isn't suitable for ANY unit. Exit at junction 8 or 6 of the M25
- ✓ Barrier fob issued on arrival

Accessing the facilities

Facility access restrictions:

- ✓ Code operated door locks

Connectivity

- ✓ Mobile phone signal – poor. Mobile phone signal may vary depending on network provider
- ✓ TV reception – fair. Booster or external aerial recommended
- ✓ Club Wi-Fi. Premium wifi – charges apply. Free wifi to the pitch

In an emergency

Emergency out of hours contact information can be found on the reception door/window.

Laundry facilities

- ✓ Machines are operated by contactless debit or credit card only. All washing machine cycles are £5 and a 6 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1.25
