Things to do

1 Cape Wrath

The most north-westerly point of the UK, the cape is separated from the mainland by the Kyle of Durness, a moorland wilderness. See spectacular coastline views over the Atlantic Ocean.

2 Ferrycroft Visitor Centre

Featuring 3 thematic exhibition rooms that bring the Highland landscape to life, the Centre is a great base for exploring the outdoors, local history and wildlife.

3 Strathnaver Museum

Discover the vibrant culture and mythical past inherited from Norse and Gaelic ancestors. A fascinating story of 8,000 years of human occupation in the north-west.

4 RSPB Forsinard Reserve

A globally vital habitat serving as the gateway to the UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for vast, rugged expanses of bog, sheltered straths and rare upland wildlife. Explore via boardwalks leading to vantage points.

5 Fishing in Loch Naver

This fishing spot is renowned for wild brown trout, sea trout and Atlantic salmon. Spanning 6 miles, it's a dramatic, traditional fishing experience in stunning mountains.

6 The Big Shoot – Altass

Everyone can enjoy the hilariously fun and competitive thrills of Clay Pigeon Shooting.

7 The Clo Mor Cliffs

The highest sea cliffs on the British mainland (over 900 feet), with sheer rock faces hosting immense seabird colonies and dramatic wilderness experiences with spectacular views.

8 Lairg

A tranquil Highland village nestled on the southern shores of Loch Shin, with views of lush green hills, snow-capped mountains and vast moorlands packed with wildlife.

Walk

Ben Klibreck, Ben Hee, Ben Hope, Ben Loyal and Ben Griam Mor are amongst the hills which can be viewed from the observation cairn, a 20 minute walk from site.

Cycle

The Highlands has been recognised by the International Mountain Bike Association as one of the greatest biking destinations offering an abundance of trails, forest and wilderness riding to suit all levels and abilities.
