Things to do

- 1 Scotland's Secret Bunker**
A Cold War command centre located 100 feet beneath a farmhouse. Once an RAF station, it was converted to house military to govern in the event of a nuclear attack.
- 2 The British Golf Museum**
Documenting over 400 years of golfing history, with over 17,000 objects, exhibits and a rooftop café overlooking the Old Course.
- 3 Caithness Glass**
Marvel at exquisite glassware fused with vibrant colours, metallic inclusions and air bubbles, each piece is individually hand-blown from sand and shaped by skilled artisans.
- 4 Falkland Palace and Garden**
Residence and Royal Palace of the Stuart Kings and Queens. And one of the favourite hunting and tennis places of Mary Queen of Scots!
- 5 Scottish Deer Centre**
A wildlife park home to over 150 animals spanning 31 species, including deer, wolves, brown bears and birds of prey with adventure play areas and daily falconry shows
- 6 Cluny Activities**
The largest outdoor adventure centre in Fife offering activities from golf, footgolf, segways, zipwires and an outdoor adventure playground.
- 7 Eden Mill Distillery**
An independent Scotch whisky and gin distillery known for its estuary views, with a modern visitor centre and immersive tasting experiences.
- 8 St Andrews**
A coastal town famous as the 'Home of Golf' and Scotland's oldest university. Blending ecclesiastical history with vibrant student life and world-class golf championship links.
- 9 Loch Leven**
The largest shallow loch famous for its wild brown trout fishery. Visit the most notable landmark Loch Leven Castle, where Mary Queen of Scots was imprisoned before her escape!
- 10 Perth**
A vibrant city on the River Tay. Blending rich history and Georgian architecture with a lively shopping scene, cultural venues and access to the rugged beauty of the Highlands.

Walk

The site is surrounded by farmland and lochs so it's easy to find routes to explore.

The East and West Lomond Hills are a great starting point for walking and hiking trails of all abilities. There are also plenty of routes along the Fife coastline.

Visit RSPB Vane Farm at Loch Leven to explore the wetlands dotted with bird hides.

Cycle

The open, hilly terrain combined with pockets of woodland is a mountain biker's dream. Try the Glenrothes Circular, starting at Balbirnie Street car park.

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 1: Dover to Shetland.
