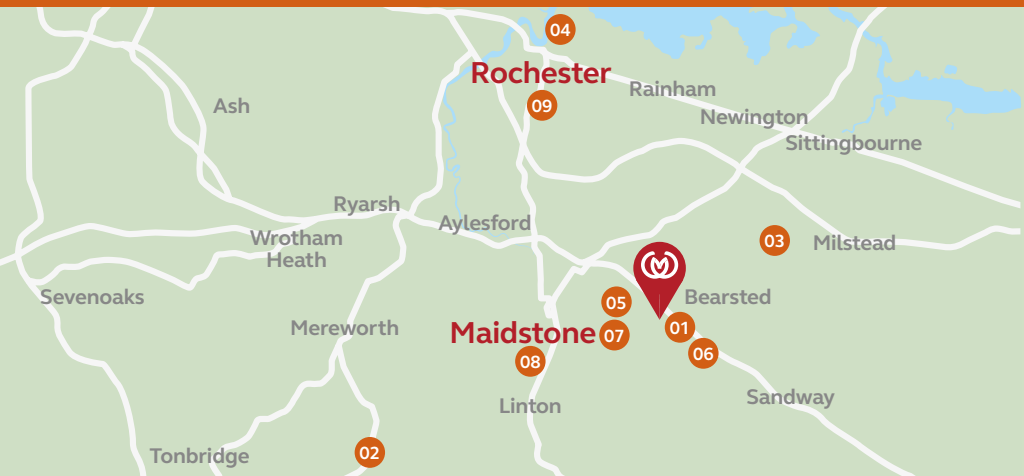


Bearsted Club Campsite

Things to do

- 1 Leeds Castle**
Set in 500 acres of beautiful parkland with adventure playground, falconry, gardens, vineyard, Go Ape and Segway.
- 2 Hop Farm Family Park**
Family attraction including adventure play area, live magic shows and animal farm.
- 3 Bredgar and Wormshill Light Railway**
Steam locomotives, traction engines, model railway and vintage vehicles.
- 4 Chatham Historic Dockyard**
Explore the world's most complete dockyard of the age of sail.
- 5 Fishing**
Fish at Major Lakes (1 mile) or Monks Lakes (12 miles).

- 6 Golf**
Marriot Tudor Park is within 0.5 mile of the site, and Leeds Castle also has a beautiful 9-hole course.
- 7 Mote Park**
Try watersports from canoeing and sailing to surfing and stand up paddleboard. Also great for walking, feeding the ducks. Dogs friendly with a cafe on site.
- 8 Maidstone**
This town offers great shopping and dining, alongside a wealth of museums, galleries, beautiful parks and gardens.
- 9 Rochester**
Steeped in rich history and culture, this stunning city is famous for being the home to Charles Dickens (see some of the buildings he wrote about in his works), as well as England's second-oldest Cathedral.

Walk

Several footpaths are close by, including paths to Leeds Castle and to Bearsted village where there is a delightful pub.

A short bus ride gives access to The North Downs Way, a beautiful ridge walk with terrific views.

Cycle

There are lovely cycling trails in nearby Mote Park.

Running between Aylesford and Barming Bridge, the River Medway is a serene river ride which soaks up the beautiful sights and sounds of the riverbank.
