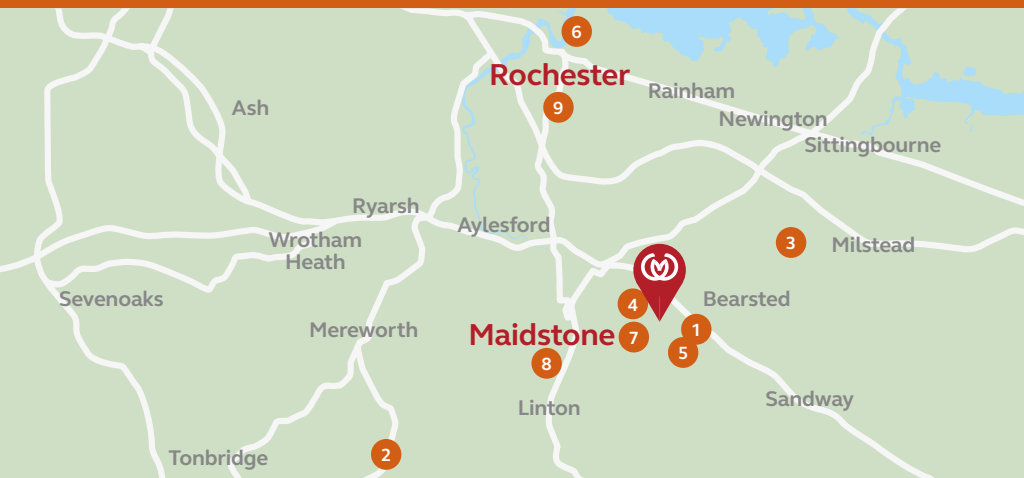


Bearsted Club Campsite

Things to do

- 1 Leeds Castle**
A stunning fortress on 2 islands on the River Len, surrounded by 500 acres of parkland. The estate contains an adventure playground, falconry, vineyards, Go Ape and Segway.
- 2 Hop Farm Family Park**
Famed for the world's largest collection of Victorian oast houses, it offers family-friendly activities, an animal farm and play areas.
- 3 Chatham Historic Dockyard**
An 80 acre maritime museum spanning 400 years of British history, featuring warships and galleries – a popular filming location.
- 4 Fishing**
Mature woodland lakes and scenic river fishing. The area is renowned for Majors Lakes, a historically significant and well-stocked fishery providing coarse and trout angling.
- 5 Golf**
A variety of golfing from scenic parkland courses to championship layouts – Cobtree Manor Park, the Marriott Tudor Park Hotel and The Ridge Golf Club.
- 6 Bredgar and Wormshill Light Railway**
A narrow-gauge heritage line between Warren Wood and Stony Shaw. Built as a hobby the track transports through woodlands and parklands on steam and diesel trains.
- 7 Mote Park**
A sprawling 450 acre park with landscaped grounds, a boating lake and woodlands. Offering walking trails, a watersports centre, miniature railway and festival spaces.
- 8 Maidstone**
The county town of Kent along the River Medway. Known as the Garden of England, it is a major economic and cultural hub.
- 9 Rochester**
A historic town famous for its Roman origins, Norman Castle and ties to Charles Dickens. It offers a charming high street, ancient cathedrals and rich literary heritage.

Walk

Several footpaths are close by, including paths to Leeds Castle and to Bearsted village where there is a delightful pub.

A short bus ride gives access to The North Downs Way, a ridge walk with terrific views.

Cycle

There are lovely cycling trails in nearby Mote Park.

Running between Aylesford and Barming Bridge, the River Medway is a serene river ride which soaks up the beautiful sights and sounds of the riverbank.

Site access restrictions:

- ✓ Barrier fob issued on arrival

Connectivity

- ✓ Mobile phone signal – fair. Mobile phone signal may vary depending on network provider
- ✓ TV reception. Booster aerial available if required
- ✓ Club Wi-Fi. Premium wifi – *charges apply*. Free wifi to the pitch

Useful information

Leeds Castle is within walking distance of the site. Members get a 20% discount on the admission price by presenting a valid membership card at the entrance.

Bearsted Village and the Woodland Trust are both accessible by foot, located within 1.5 miles of the site.

The Butcher's Block at the Bell Oak, The George Inn and The Oak on the Green offer discounts to Club members.
