Things to do

1 Dover Castle

A medieval fortress perched on the White Cliffs to guard the shortest sea crossing, earning it the name 'Key to England'. Enter the Secret Wartime Tunnels and climb the Great Tower.

2 Romney, Hythe and Dymchurch Railway

A heritage light railway from Hythe to Dungeness, through the Romney Marsh. Kent's mainline in miniature, the 15-inch gauge track runs third-size steam and diesel locomotives.

3 Howletts Wild Animal Park

A wildlife sanctuary renowned for conservation and breeding success – the UK's largest herd of African elephants and an world famous family of western lowland gorillas.

4 Kent Ballooning

A hot air balloon operator offering sunrise and sunset flights across the 'Garden of England', with panoramic views of the countryside and coastline.

5 Kent Gliding Centre

A centre atop the North Downs, offering spectacular aerial views serving both experienced glider pilots and beginners looking for new flying experiences!

6 The Kent Downs

A protected National Landscape, defined by parallel chalk and greensand ridges, ancient woodlands, parklands and the North Downs Way.

7 Canterbury

A cathedral city on the River Stour. This walled city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site that blends ancient architecture, vibrant student culture and literary heritage.

8 Ashford

A market town on the River Stour, perfectly balancing rural charm with modern regeneration. Famed for transport links, bustling retail hubs and award-winning vineyards.

Walk

Follow the 7 mile route from Canterbury to Whitstable along Crab and Winkle Way.

Or another 7 mile route along the cliff tops with great views on the Folkestone to Dover Coastal Path.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 2: Dover to Eden – section 1, Dover to Hastings.

Cathedral to coast is a 50 mile circular ride using Regional Routes 16 and 17 linking Dover, Canterbury and Folkestone along leafy lanes and bridleways, rolling hills, woodlands and country villages.
