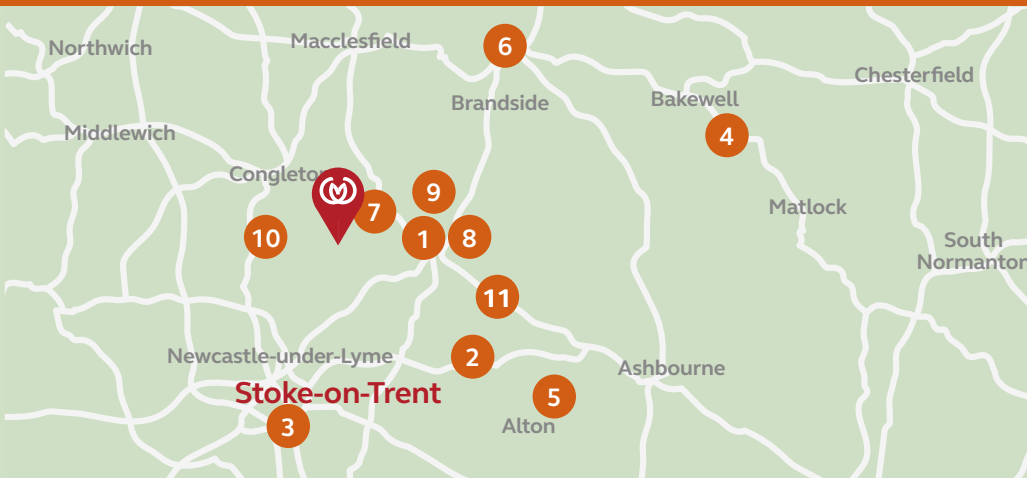

Things to do

- 1 Brindley Mill Museum**
A restored 18th Century working corn mill built by renowned engineer James Brindley.
- 2 Churnet Valley Railway**
A preserved heritage steam railway with train journeys through the picturesque Churnet Valley.
- 3 Trentham Estate**
Spectacular landscaped gardens, protected ancient woodlands, a unique shopping village and a free-roaming monkey forest.
- 4 Haddon Hall**
Over 900 years-old, one of the UK's most elegant and timeless stately homes, with medieval kitchens, a long gallery and terraced gardens.
- 5 Alton Towers**
Thrilling rides and amazing live shows for all the family.
- 6 Poole's Cavern**
A two-million-year-old natural limestone cave – the most spectacular cavern in the Peak District.

- 7 Rudyard Lake**
A large, scenic freshwater reservoir renowned for calm, shallow waters perfect for fishing, sailing or canoeing.
- 8 Leek**
A traditional market town, with a rich textile heritage and an unspoilt stone-cobbled market square with shops, cafés and pubs.
- 9 Tittesworth Reservoir**
On the edge of the National Park, this popular visitor spot for walking trails, watersports, a large children's playground with a sandpit and views of The Roaches.
- 10 Little Moreton Hall**
A remarkably preserved 16th Century, timber-framed, moated manor house, famous for its higgledy-piggledy warped appearance.
- 11 Peak Wildlife Park**
An immersive, walk-through zoo featuring large, interactive habitats where you can walk alongside the animals. Home to exotic animals including polar bears, penguins, alpaca, zebra and wallaby.

Walk

Enjoy panoramic scenery which, on a clear day, allows you to see much of Cheshire, Winter Hill in Lancashire and even Snowdon!

Enjoy woodland walks and fascinating birdlife all year round at RSPB Coombes Valley.

The Roaches rock formation is walkable from site. Turn right out of site, take the first left down a footpath, over a bridge and turn left when you reach the road at the top.

Cycle

The Manifold Trail route follows the disused Leek and Manifold Light Railway through the Manifold and Hamps Valleys from Waterhouses to Hulme End. The route is around 8 miles, (16 miles to return).
