Things to do

1 Cotswold Farm Park

Interact closely and meet over 50 rare and native breeds including the Golden Guernsey goats and Highland cattle, with seasonal demonstrations and children's activities.

2 Sudeley Castle and Gardens

The last home and burial place of the Tudor Queen Katherine Parr. With award-winning gardens, romantic ruins, a rare breeds pheasantry and adventure playground.

3 Birdland Park and Gardens

A 9 acre park on the River Windrush hosting over 500 bird breeds from around the world, including King Penguins and flamingoes.

4 Batsford Arboretum

60 acre tree-filled sanctuary of diverse trees, wild flowers and Japanese inspired design. One of the largest private tree collections in the UK.

5 Cotswold Falconry Centre

Eagles, hawks, owls, vultures and falcons give daily flying demonstrations, educating with speed, grace and agility.

6 The Model Village

The only Grade II listed model village, replicating Bourton-on-the-Water. Featuring a flowing river, churches with recorded choir music and a model village within the model village!

7 Cotswold Motoring and Toy Museum

A collection of rare vehicles and retro memorabilia giving a nostalgic journey through 20th Century motoring history and a treasure trove of children's toys, including Brum!

8 Moreton-in-Marsh

A thriving market town renowned for its unusually wide High Street, honey-coloured Cotswold stone architecture and bustling 800 year-old Tuesday market.

9 Gloucester

Steeped in over 2,000 years of history, this city boasts a magnificent castle, docks and lots of museums, shops and attractions.

Walk

There are plenty of scenic walks through the landscape of the Cotswolds. Starting by the River Windrush in Bourton-on-the-Water, pass to Lower Slaughter and walk along the River Eye to Upper Slaughter.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 48: Tetbury and Cirencester to Northleach, Moreton-in-Marsh and Southam.
