Things to do

1 Broadway Tower

An iconic Gothic folly by Capability Brown, the second-highest point in the Cotswolds, famous for its panoramic views that can stretch up to 62 miles and span 16 counties.

2 Cotswold Farm Park

Interact closely and meet over 50 rare and native breeds including the Golden Guernsey goats and Highland cattle, with seasonal demonstrations and children's activities.

3 Gloucestershire Warwickshire Steam Railway

A spectacular 14 mile heritage railway through the Cotswolds, offering a nostalgic journey with stunning views of the Malvern Hills and Vale of Evesham.

4 Cotswold Falconry Centre

Eagles, hawks, owls, vultures and falcons give daily flying demonstrations, educating with speed, grace and agility.

5 Evesham Leisure Centre

A multi-purpose community facility with large state-of-the-art gym, swimming pools, exercise classes and a soft play area.

6 Snowhill Manor

A 16th Century country house and the former home of unconventional architect and poet Charles Paget Wade, whose fascination and treasure trove of quirky objects are displayed.

7 Tewkesbury

An ancient market town at the confluence of the Rivers Severn and Avon. Renowned for stunning medieval architecture, timber-framed buildings and the 12th Century Tewkesbury Abbey.

8 Batsford Arboretum

60 acre tree-filled sanctuary of diverse trees, wild flowers and Japanese inspired design. One of the largest private tree collections in the UK.

Walk

Running close to the site, the scenic Cotswold Way trail offers 100 miles of magical walks through picturesque villages and stunning scenery.

Explore 55 magical acres of woodland, gardens, wild flowers, caves and waterfalls at Batsford Arboretum.

Cycle

The nearest route to the site is 41: Rugby to Bath on the National Cycle Network.
