Walk

This (sometimes strenuous) circular walk of Peel Tower, Holcombe Moor and Ramsbottom, gives spectacular views, woodland, rivers and heritage.

For a gentler stroll, Burrs Country Park is adjacent to the site. It has a variety of wildlife habitats to explore. The dog-friendly Lampost Cafe is also located here, ideal for enjoying a bite to eat.

Cycle

The nearest route to this site is 6 on the national cycle network. A 390 mile route from London to Keswick. The Bury circular cycle route is around 13 miles across rural hills north of Bury.
