Things to do

- 1 East Lancashire Railway**
A heritage railway operating mostly steam-hauled trains through the scenic Irwell Valley from Heywood in Manchester to Rawtenstall. A trip back to the golden age of steam.
- 2 The Irwell Sculpture Trail**
The UK's largest sculpture route, stretching 33 miles featuring 70+ artworks positioned along the route of the meandering River Irwell.
- 3 Bury Market**
Celebrated as 'Britain's Favourite Market', the space features over 350 indoor and outdoor stalls. Famous for delicacies such as Bury Black Pudding and the bustling Fish and Meat Hall.
- 4 Manchester United Museum**
Explore the 'Theatre of Dreams' at Old Trafford – the world's first and largest club football museum. Chronicling the club's heritage with exhibits, artifacts and silverware.
- 5 The Trafford Centre**
An iconic and enormous indoor shopping and entertainment complex, famous for its luxurious marble malls and unique architecture.
- 6 MediaCity UK**
A vibrant mixed-use waterfront destination serving as a major international hub for broadcasting, digital technology and the arts.
- 7 Bury**
A vibrant former mill town renowned for its open-air market, blending rich Industrial Revolution history with Pennine countryside.
- 8 Bolton**
A large town near the West Pennine Moors, boasting a proud industrial heritage rooted in textiles and coal. Serving as a hub for Victorian architecture and modern culture.
- 9 Manchester**
A dynamic city famous for being the world's first industrial metropolis. Celebrated for its deep-rooted music history, world-class football and thriving arts and culture scene.

Walk

The sometimes strenuous circular walk of Peel Tower, Holcombe Moor and Ramsbottom give spectacular views of woodland, rivers and heritage.

For a more gentle stroll, Burrs Country Park is adjacent to the site with a variety of wildlife habitats to explore. The dog-friendly Lamppost Café is also located here, ideal for enjoying a bite to eat.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 6: a 390 mile route from London to Keswick. The Bury Circular cycle route is around 13 miles across rural hills north of Bury.
