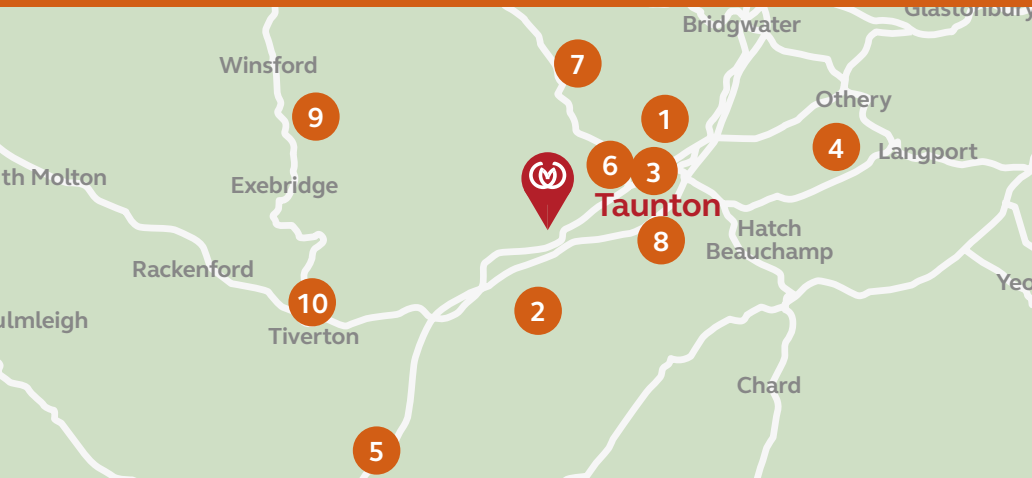

Things to do

- 1 Hestercombe Gardens**
A spectacular 50 acre estate showcasing 3 centuries of garden design. The site blends 18th Century landscapes with intimate, world-renowned Edwardian designs.
- 2 Hemyock Castle**
A ruined and preserved 14th Century moated Castle featuring circular corner towers, high curtain walls and a prominent gatehouse.
- 3 The Museum of Somerset**
A historic 12th Century Castle telling the county's 400 million-year story. Organised into 9 galleries, artifacts including fossils and mosaics, mix with modern, audio-visual displays.
- 4 RSPB West Sedgemoor**
A Site of Special Scientific Interest and part of England's largest remaining wet meadow system. Home to large populations of breeding waders in summer and wildfowl in winter.
- 5 Quad World – Exeter**
An exhilarating family-friendly, all-weather outdoor quad-biking centre offering guided sessions on a half-mile track.

- 6 Somerset Adventures**
Outdoor guided adventures across diverse land and water activities – canoeing on the calm waters of the Bridgewater Canal, or bushcraft skills in the Blackdown Hills.
- 7 Quantock Trekking**
Guided treks on horseback through the breathtaking moorland trails and woodlands of the Quantock Hills, catering to all abilities.
- 8 Taunton**
The bustling market town on the River Tone, famous for its Norman castle and Somerset Cricket Club. Serving as the West Country's central hub for arts, culture and business.
- 9 Exmoor National Park**
A rare sense of wilderness and tranquillity – landscapes of moorland, woodland, valleys and farmland and Europe's first dark sky reserve.
- 10 Tiverton**
A market town at the confluence of the Rivers Exe and Lowman. And a commercial hub offering excellent transport links.

Walk

Wellington is a 15 minute walk away. The Quantock and Brendon Hills are to the north and Blackdown Hills to the south.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network is route 3: Bristol to Land's End.
