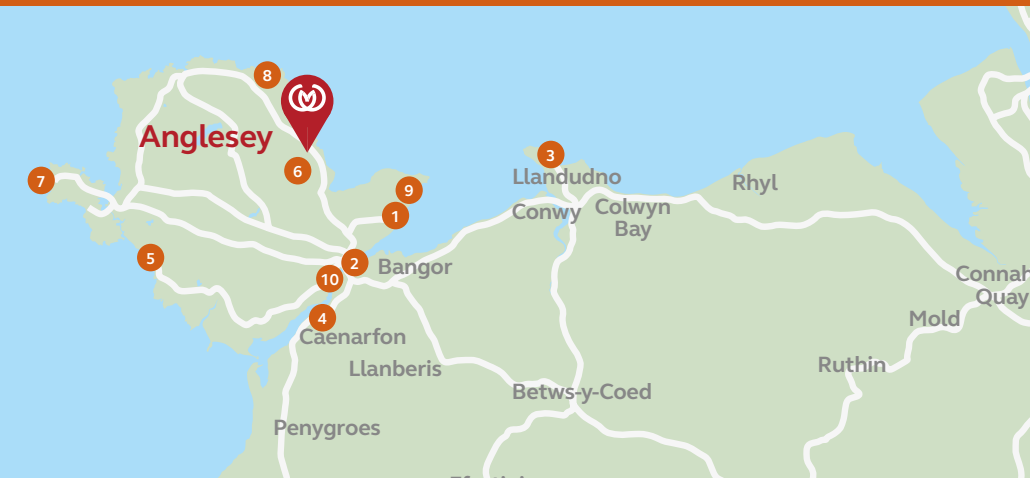

Things to do

1 Beaumaris Castle

The great unfinished masterpiece designed for Edward I. Renowned as the most technically perfect example of concentric walls-within-walls with near-perfect symmetry.

2 Menai Bridge

Iron suspension bridge connecting Anglesey with mainland Wales – the world's first major suspension bridge, featuring a 176 metre span and 16 massive iron chain cables.

3 Llandudno Pier

A Grade II listed 700 metre-long Victorian structure stretching into the Irish Sea. It features iron columns with wooden decking and offers panoramic views.

4 Welsh Highland Railway

The UK's longest heritage railway, running 25 miles through the heart of Snowdonia National Park.

5 Windsurfing

Rhosneigr and Trearddur Bay are two premier windsurfing locations on Anglesey. Offering a mix of waves and accessible sandy bays.

6 Golf

There are 6 courses known for their stunning coastal backdrops, views of the Snowdonia mountain range and year-round playability due to the mild climate.

7 RSPB South Stack and Lighthouse

A dramatic nature reserve to enjoy watching seabirds including puffins, guillemots and razorbills.

8 Amlwch

A peaceful port town with a industrial copper-mining past – highlighted by the Parys Mountain's iconic rust-coloured terrain.

9 Beaumaris

A captivating seaside town boasting stunning views of the Menai Strait and Snowdonia, with charming streets and pastel-coloured cottages.

10 Plas Newydd House

A Grade I listed house and 40 acre grounds, on the banks of the Menai Strait, a National Landscape.

Walk

There are plenty of places to walk on the island with beautiful and varied coastal scenery. The Coastal Path can be reached from Traeth Bychan.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 5: Bangor to Conwy.
