Things to do

1 Sudeley Castle and Gardens

The last home and burial place of the Tudor Queen Katherine Parr. With award-winning gardens, romantic ruins, a rare breeds pheasantry and adventure playground.

2 Gloucester Cathedral

Some of the most significant medieval architecture in the world, the cathedral is the burial place of Edward II and contains an acoustic Whispering Gallery.

3 Mechanical Music Museum

A unique attraction focusing on self-playing instruments and fairground organs from the pre-digital era.

4 Nature In Art

The world's first dedicated museum for art inspired by nature, housing over 2,000 works – including pieces by Picasso.

5 Gloucester Ski and Snowboard Centre

One of the longest outdoor artificial ski slopes in the UK for skiing and snowboarding fun all year round.

6 Head 4 Heights

A popular outdoor aerial adventure park offering high-ropes challenges, pole climbs, free falls and trapeze jumps for children and families.

7 Combat Splat Archery and Air Rifle Ranges

Professionally instructed, all-weather shooting activities including traditional archery and precision air rifle shooting for all skill levels, individuals and family groups.

8 Cheltenham

The cultural capital of the Cotswolds, this affluent spa town is renowned for horse racing, theatre and festivals and high-end shopping.

9 Gloucester

Steeped in over 2,000 years of history, this city boasts a magnificent castle, docks and lots of museums, shops and attractions.

10 Cotswold Farm Park

Interact closely and meet over 50 rare and native breeds including the Golden Guernsey goats and Highland cattle, with seasonal demonstrations and children's activities.

Walk

A good route near site is the circular walk around the outside of the racecourse – do not walk on the racecourse itself.

There is another larger circular walk around Cheltenham which is 25 minutes away (on foot) and both Cleeve Hill and the Cotswold Way Valley are also nearby.

Cycle

Pittville Park is a great place for cycling. The nearest National Cycle Network route is 41: Severn Bridge to Stratford.

Accessing the site

Site access restrictions:

- ✓ A racecourse security pass is needed. This can be collected from reception and must be displayed in your vehicle at all times
- ✓ Return your racecourse security pass to reception via the letter box before leaving

Accessing the facilities

Facility access restrictions:

- ✓ Code operated door locks
- ✓ Unlocked accessible room
- ✓ Motorhomes to use the 'drive-over' motorhome service and freshwater point located near the ladies facilities

Connectivity

- ✓ Mobile phone signal – good. Mobile phone signal may vary depending on network provider
- ✓ TV reception – fair (booster or external aerial suggested)
- ✓ Racecourse Wi-Fi provided by The Jockey Club

In an emergency

Emergency out of hours contact information can be found on the reception door/window.

Laundry facilities

- ✓ Machines are coin operated only. All washing machine cycles are £4 and a 15 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1

Pets

- ✓ Dog walk around the periphery of the racecourse (on lead) accessible to the left of the main gates

Useful information

There's no children's play area on site, but Pittville Park Children's Play is a 20 minute walk away. Pittville Park is split into two sides:

- ✓ East side has a huge play area with a kiosk, aviaries, lake, toilets, café, Sundae Shack and lots of green events space
- ✓ West side has a boating lake, boathouse, pitch and putt golf course, tennis courts, natural play equipment and a skateboarding/BMX area

Cheltenham Town Centre is a 30 minute walk from site.
