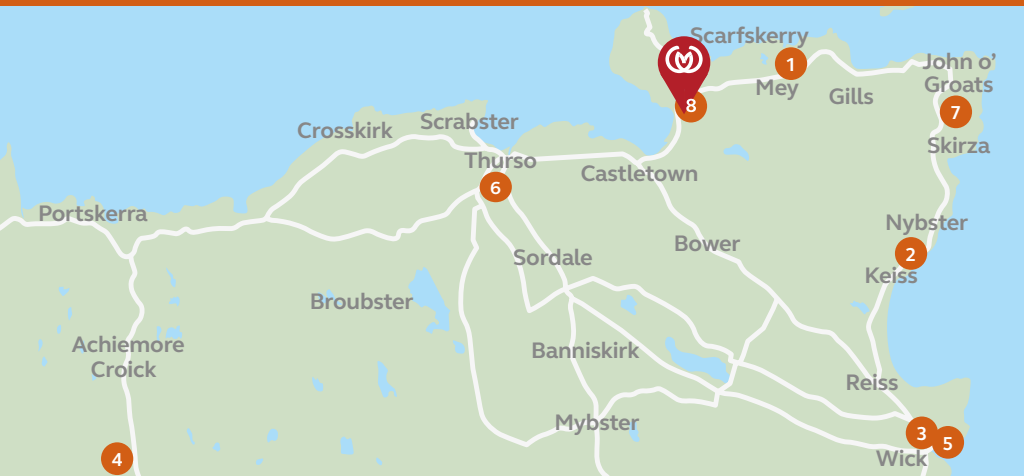

Things to do

- 1 The Castle of Mey**
A 16th Century tower house purchased and restored by The Queen Mother. Overlooking the Pentland Firth, it serves as a historic and cosy royal retreat.
- 2 Keiss Castle**
Visit the striking and dramatic ruins of the 16th Century tower house, standing on the edge of a sheer cliff – a hauntingly beautiful landmark.
- 3 Wick Heritage Museum**
Open Easter to October, a rambling treasure trove dedicated to preserving the town of Wick's rich fishing history and local culture.
- 4 RSPB Forsinard Flows Nature Reserve**
Europe's largest expanse of blanket bog, this globally significant peatland habitat is a unique landscape of peat pools, colourful sphagnum mosses and rare wildlife.
- 5 Caithness Seacoast**
Enjoy more of Caithness with a thrilling powerboat trip. Discover sea stacks, caves, harbours, lighthouses and wildlife with expert commentary.
- 6 Thurso**
The most northerly town on British mainland, known as a major surfing destination and gateway to the Orkney Islands.
- 7 John O'Groats**
A small, scenic coastal village famously known as the 'end of the GB road'. A popular tourist spot for its iconic, often-photographed signpost – marking the 876 mile distance to Land's End.
- 8 Dunnet Bay Distillery**
An award-winning, family-owned craft distillery of gin, rum and vodka nestled near Dunnet Bay on the iconic North Coast 500 route.

Walk

Follow the steps onto the beach for a walk along Dunnet Bay. The whole length of the beach takes less than 2 hours. Alternatively, head to Mary Ann's Cottage, and then on to Dwarwick Pier and take the coastal path to the remote and beautiful Peedie Beach.

Explore Dunnet Forest and follow the circular route on woodland paths. Along the way you'll find sculptures, a log cabin and a giant wooden xylophone.

Cycle

Thurso to Dunnet Head is a relatively low difficulty 10 mile route.

Bike hire is available from Dunnet Head Holidays Bike Hire.

The nearest National Cycle Network route 1: runs between Inverness and John O'Groats, swooping beneath Dunnet Bay and can be joined from Castletown.
