At a Glance



Level Access

- The site is set relatively level throughout



Step only Access

- The dog walk has a 160mm high step
- The cooking shelter in the camping area has a small step from a gravel path to access



Accessible Toilets and Showers

- There is a combined accessible toilet and shower cubicle in both of the toilet blocks
- There is an accessible toilet cubicle in both of the toilet blocks

- No designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.

Arrival and Reception

Approach Route

- Access onto the site is via a tarmac driveway
- The reception building is on the left hand side of the entrance road
- The gate from the road is left open at all times but access into the site is controlled via a vehicle barrier controlled by ANPR.
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

Parking

- There are four spaces for new arrivals within a few meters of the reception building
- There is space for 3 cars, 2 charging points and 1 marked disabled bay within 15 meters of Reception
- There is space for 3 Late Night Arrivals opposite reception
- The route from the parking area to the reception is step free, with a gentle gradient

Entrance into Reception

- There is a dropped kerb which gives access to the pavement outside of reception
- The Entrance door is 1000mm wide, over a level threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens inwards



Reception

- There is approximately 3300mm x 2300 turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 880mm above the floor with no knee space with no dropped section
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop
- There are some items available for sale behind the reception desk



Getting around the Site

- The site is generally set relatively level throughout
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac, but do incorporate speed bumps

Touring Pitches

- There are 156 pitches on site, 142 of which are hardstanding
- Temporary multipurpose access rubber matting is not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- There are 8 hardstanding pitches which are between 5 and 30 meters from Toilet Block A and between 50 and 100 meters from reception, these would be the most suitable pitches for people with accessibility needs

Camping Pitches

- There are 10 camping pitches on the camping field to the west of the site
- There is a cooking shelter, which has access via a path
- There is parking to the north of the field



Toilets and Changing Facilities

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block A

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is set to the east of the site.
- The toilet block is accessed via dropped kerbs to a paved path around the toilet block
- The door is 800mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards

- The cubicle door is secured by a RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 2000mm x 2700mm
- The WC pan is right hand transfer.
- The shower seat is left hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 480mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1400mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 1000mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1450mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers



Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block B

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is set to the west of the site.
- The toilet block is accessed via dropped kerbs to a paved path around the toilet block
- The door is 800mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by a RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 1900mm x 2600mm
- The WC pan is left hand transfer.

- The shower seat is right hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 480mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1200mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 1000mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1300mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers



Accessible Toilet Cubicle - Toilet Block A

- There is an accessible toilet cubicle in the Toilet Block, which is set to the east of the site
- There is a dropped kerb to the pathway around the toilet block, which gives access to the Accessible Toilet Cubicle
- The door is 780mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 1500mm x 2300mm
- The WC pan is right hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 700mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The WC Pan is fitted with grab rails to assist transfer

- The basin taps are fitted with levers

Accessible Toilet Cubicle - Toilet Block B

- There is an accessible toilet cubicle in the Toilet Block, which is set to the west of the site
- There is a dropped kerb to the pathway around the toilet block, which gives access to the Accessible Toilet Cubicle
- The door is 800mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 1100mm x 2450mm
- The WC pan is left hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 700mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The WC Pan is fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- The basin taps are fitted with levers

Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There are two toilet blocks on site, Toilet Block A to the east of the site and Toilet Block B to the west of the site close to the camping field
- Entrance doors to the male and female areas in both blocks have digi codes or fob entry, if you require a fob to access the facilities please ask at reception. The fob and code pad are 1050mm above the ground
- The female area in Toilet Block A has 5 WC cubicles, 4 Shower cubicles and 3 Washbasin Privacy cubicles
- The male area in Toilet Block A has 4 Urinals, including 1 lowered Urinal, 3 WC cubicles, 4 Shower cubicles and 3 Washbasin Privacy cubicles
- The female area in Toilet Block B has 6 WC cubicles, 4 Shower cubicles and 1 Washbasin Privacy cubicles
- The male area in Toilet Block B has 4 Urinals, 5 WC cubicles, 4 Shower cubicles and 2 Washbasin Privacy cubicles

- There is a modified WC cubicle, Shower cubicle and Washbasin Privacy cubicle in both the male and female areas in both toilet blocks, with handrails to assist mobility
- In both blocks in the male and female areas there is a modified WC cubicle and shower cubicle, with grab rails to assist with mobility
- Taps in each block incorporate lever controls

Inclusive Room - Toilet Block A

- There is an inclusive bathroom in Toilet Block A which can be accessed via the dropped kerbs to the pathway around the toilet block
- The door is 800mm wide, over a rollover threshold and opens outwards
- The room's dimensions are 1500mm x 2300mm
- There is a half sized bathtub with a shower above, this has lever turn taps to operate
- The toilet seat is 430mm high
- There is a drop down baby change table at 900mm high
- There are lever turn taps to the basin
- There is a shower, with controls at 1000mm high and a shower head on a sliding rail between 1450mm and 2000mm
- There is a shelf at 1350mm high



Inclusive Room - Toilet Block B

- There is an inclusive bathroom in Toilet Block A which can be accessed via the dropped kerbs to the pathway around the toilet block
- The door is 780mm wide, over a rollover threshold and opens outwards
- The room's dimensions are 1500mm x 2300mm
- There is a half sized bathtub with a shower above, this has lever turn taps to operate
- The toilet seat is 430mm high
- There is a drop down baby change table at 900mm high

- There are lever turn taps to the basin
- There is a shower, with controls at 1000mm high and a shower head on a sliding rail between 1450mm and 2000mm
- There is a shelf at 1350mm high



Other Facilities

External Dishwashing – Toilet Block A

- There is open and level access to the dishwashing area at the side of the toilet block
- There is 1200mm clear space behind the sinks
- There are 4 sinks at 900mm high with no knee space below
- Lever taps available



External Dishwashing – Toilet Block B

- There is open and level access to the dishwashing area at the side of the toilet block
- There is 2400mm clear space behind the sinks
- There are 4 sinks at 900mm high with no knee space below
- Lever taps available



Dishwashing and Laundry Room – Toilet Block A

- The dishwashing and laundry room can be accessed via the path around the toilet block
- The door opens to 800mm wide over a rollover threshold and opens inwards
- There is 2000mm x 2500mm clear space within the room
- There are 2 sinks in an 850mm high counter with 550mm knee space below
- There is a front loading washing machine and a front loading tumble dryer
- Lever taps available



Dishwashing and Laundry Room – Toilet Block B

- The dishwashing and laundry room can be accessed via the path around the toilet block
- The door opens to 800mm wide over a rollover threshold and opens outwards
- There is 1250mm x 2300mm clear space within the room
- There are 3 sinks in an 850mm high counter with 550mm knee space below
- There is a front loading washing machine and a front loading tumble dryer
- Lever taps available



Drying Room – Toilet Block B

- The drying room can be accessed via the path around the toilet block
- The door is 680mm wide with a rollover threshold and opens outwards
- There is 1450mm x 1700mm maneuvering space
- The bench is 630mm high
- There are hooks at 1830mm high



Information Room – Adjacent to Reception

- Access via the pavement around reception building
- There is a step free approach into the room
- The door is 900mm wide over a level threshold and opens inwards
- There is a keypad at 1550mm high to access the room
- There is a minimum of 800mm wide walkways throughout the room
- Information is displayed between 750mm and 1700mm



Dog Walk

- There is a dog walking area to the center of site
- There is a 600mm wide gate with a latch at 1200mm high
- There is a 160mm high step into the dog walking area
- The ground here is natural and can get muddy in wet weather



Play Area

- There is a play area to the south of the site
- There are 850mm wide entrances to the play area
- The play equipment is mounted on safety flooring



Service Points

- There are Service Points at intervals around the site, please check the site map for details
- These have level access from adjacent road ways
- The water taps are at a maximum of 780mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Emptying Points can be found here too with ledges at 520mm high and taps at 1130mm high



Motorhome Service Point

- There are two Motorhome Service Points on site, one at each toilet block
- The Motorhome Service Point taps at Toilet Block A are 1130mm high mounted on a 100mm kerb
- The Motorhome Service Point taps at Toilet Block B are 770mm high mounted on a 130mm kerb
