Things to do

1 Galloway House Gardens

These charity-run gardens feature a restored walled garden, romantic woodland walks and a sandy beach on Rigg Bay, showcasing exotic shrubs, rhododendrons and bulbs.

2 Kirroughtree Visitor Centre

An eco-facility and gateway to the Galloway Forest Park, serving as a central hub for walking, mountain biking and stargazing beneath the award-winning Gold Tier Dark Skies.

3 Bladnoch Distillery

A lowland single malt distillery, producing 1.5 million litres of floral whisky annually. Offering tours that showcase the production process.

4 Galloway Distillery

An innovative craft distillery co-owned by *Outlander* actor Sam Heughan, producing Hills & Harbour Gin and The Sassenach using a wheat-based spirit with local botanicals.

5 Kitchen Coos & Ewes

Farm tours centred on Highland cows and Beltex sheep. Providing educational and photographic safari experiences via trailer and on foot.

6 Whithorn Priory and Museum

Known as the 'cradle of Christianity' this historic site where St. Ninian established a Christian community around 397 AD. Although in ruins, the priory remains a significant place of pilgrimage.

7 Wigtown

Officially designated as Scotland's National Book Town, with ample book shops, an annual Book Festival and a quiet, quaint atmosphere with easy access to tranquil coastal walks.

8 Glenwhan Gardens

Described as one of the most beautiful made gardens in Scotland, this botanical paradise is known for spectacular, elevated views over Luce Bay to the Isle of Man.

9 Kirkcudbright Artists Town

A picturesque harbour fishing town celebrated for its unique coastal light, vibrant Georgian architecture, pastel coloured houses and rich, century-long legacy as a thriving creative colony.

Walk

Coastal walks are reachable directly from site.

Historical journeys discovering woodlands, beaches, hills, flora and fauna on The Whithorn Way. Or for gentle strolls, lochside ambles or mountain hikes head through The Galloway Forest Park.

Cycle

There are quiet roads around the site on the Machars cycle route.

7Stanes mountain biking centres in Kirroughtree and Glentrool in The Galloway Forest Park.
