Things to do

1 Brecon Beacons National Park

A spectacular protected landscape in southern Wales. Famous for its sweeping moorlands, dramatic red sandstone peaks and cascading waterfalls, it is world-renowned for hikers, nature lovers and stargazers.

2 Carreg Cennen Castle

A dramatic, Grade I listed medieval ruin atop a limestone crag. Celebrated for its rugged, romantic setting and unique architecture, including a secret cave passage.

3 Brecon Cathedral

A Grade I listed church set in the only walled cathedral close in Wales, blending Norman and Gothic architecture. The spiritual heart of the Diocese of Swansea and Brecon.

4 Aberdulais Tin Works and Waterfall

An iconic waterfall, generating over 400 years of industrial water power from the River Dulais. Explore the ruins of 19th Century tinplate mills and view Europe's largest electricity-generating waterwheel.

5 Skydive Swansea

Tandem and ground rush skydiving over the Gower Peninsula. Freefall from 15,000 feet at speeds up to 120mph, followed by a parachute ride over coastlines and cliffs.

6 Outdoor Matters

A specialist adventure provider offering rock climbing, scrambling, sea-cliff jumping and coastal activity days for all experience levels.

7 Swansea

Wales's second largest city, stretching for 5 miles along the coastline. Famed for its rich copper smelting industrial past and a vibrant cultural literary and artistic heritage.

8 Llanelli

A coastal market town where the Welsh language is widely spoken. Famous for its rugby heritage and rich tin, steel and coal industrial history.

9 Cardiff

The vibrant, multicultural capital of Wales, blending history with modern urban energy. Sitting on the southern coast with world-class sports and iconic landmarks.

Walk

All the beaches within the Gower Peninsula are in easy driving distance.

Visit Craig Gwladys Country Park to walk the forest trails and climb the steep ascent with hang-gliders soaring above.

Cycle

The Millennium Cycle Path is within 2 miles of the site and there are other routes around the Swansea and Mumbles cycle paths. Information is available from the office and the information room.

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 4: The Celtic Trail West.
