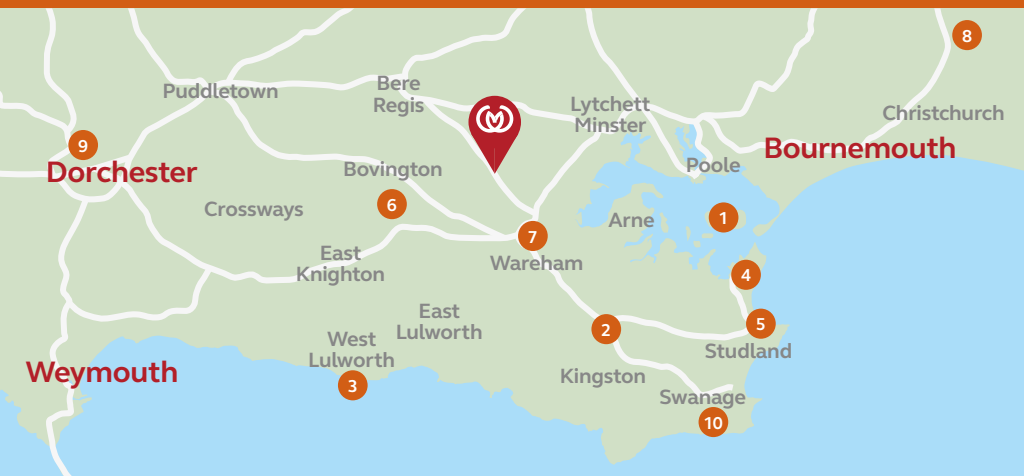

Things to do

1 Brownsea Island

The largest island in Poole Harbour, this car-free sanctuary is famous for red squirrels and peacocks. Also the birthplace of Scouting!

2 Corfe Castle

A dramatic, ruined 11th Century fortress built by William the Conqueror – one of Britain's most valued ruins, with 1,000 year history.

3 Lulworth Cove Heritage Centre

The primary gateway to the UNESCO World Heritage Jurassic Coast. Interactive geological displays prepare for exploring the famous Lulworth Crumple and Durdle Door.

4 Studland Bay

Famous for 4 miles of unspoiled, golden sandy beaches, gentle shallow waters and sweeping sand dunes – a stunning destination for beach trips, watersports and wildlife spotting.

5 Coasteering

An exhilarating adventure activity combining rock scrambling, seacave exploration and cliff jumping and a guided exploration of the rocky coastline and marine life.

6 Monkey World

A sanctuary housing over 250 animals across 20+ species, including Europe's only orangutan nursery, in spacious, naturalistic enclosures.

7 Wareham Boat Hire

Explore the River Frome with beginner-friendly motorboats, kayaks, canoes, rowing boats and paddleboards to hire.

8 The New Forest National Park

A 220 square mile sanctuary featuring ancient woodlands, open heathlands and coastal areas. Uniquely famous for its free-roaming ponies, cattle and donkeys.

9 Dorchester

The historic, vibrant town renowned for its Roman heritage. Located on the River Frome, it features a bustling high street, museums and the nearby Maiden Castle.

10 Swanage

A charming, nostalgic Victorian seaside town, highly prized for its gently sloping golden sandy beach, heritage steam railway and as the gateway to the Jurassic Coast.

Walk

This historic stretch of the Jurassic coast has miles of paths to explore while you admire the impressive views.

The Wareham to Sturminster Marshall route passes the site and offers beautiful views, an Iron Age hill fort and lots of wildlife.

Cycle

The Purbeck Cycleway is a 47 mile circular route that takes in Wareham Quay, Swanage, Corfe Castle and other scenic spots. Pick up a leaflet from the Discover Purbeck Information Centre.

Sika Cycle Trail is a 7 mile numbered trail suitable for cyclists of all ages and abilities. Cycle hire is available.

Accessing the site

Site access restrictions:

- ✓ Barrier code/fob issued on arrival

Accessing the facilities

Facility access restrictions:

- ✓ Key operated door locks on the accessible room and family room

Connectivity

- ✓ Mobile phone signal – poor. Mobile phone signal may vary depending on network provider
- ✓ TV reception – poor. Booster aerial is available on bollard, but a 25 metre aerial coaxial cable may be required
- ✓ Club Wi-Fi. Premium wifi – *charges apply*. Free wifi to the pitch

In an emergency

Emergency out of hours contact information can be found on the reception door/window and in the information room.

Laundry facilities

- ✓ Machines are token operated only. Tokens are available from reception at £1.25 each. All washing machine cycles are £5, pre-wash is £1.25 and a 15 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1.25

- ✓ Dog area/field (off lead) and dog agility area
- ✓ Dog walk from site with direct access into Wareham Forest
