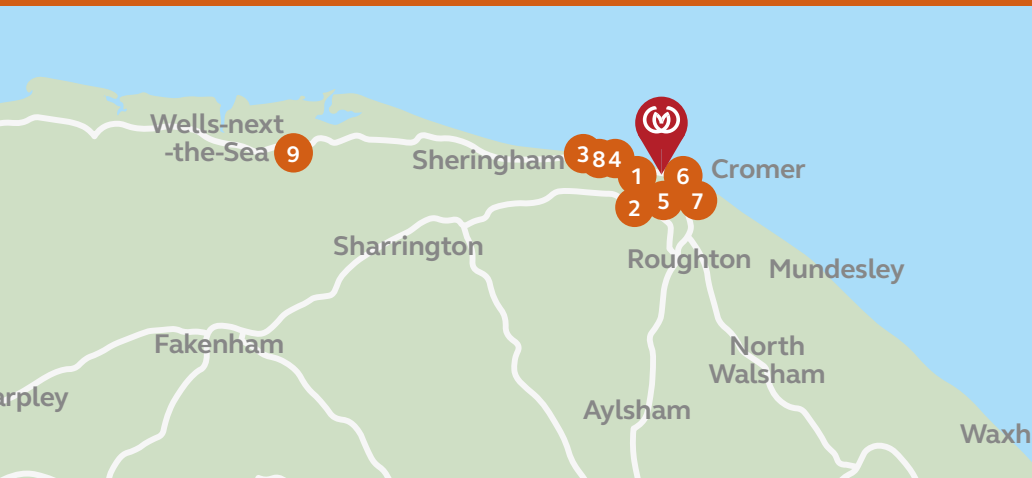

Things to do

- Hillside Shire Horse and Animal Sanctuary**
One of the UK's largest animal rescue centres. Providing permanent, safe home to over 4,000 animals, including horses, donkeys, cows, pigs and sheep.
- Felbrigg Hall**
One of the finest 17th Century country houses celebrated for its unique blend of Jacobean architecture, fine Georgian interiors and welcoming, lived-in atmosphere.
- North Norfolk Railway**
A heritage steam railway running vintage steam and diesel trains between the seaside towns of Sheringham and Holt. Also known as the Poppy Line.
- Priory Maze and Gardens**
A peaceful 10 acre visitor attraction renowned for Norfolk's only traditional hedge maze. A unique microclimate allows a variety of rare and exotic plants to thrive.
- Amazona Zoo**
A unique, Amazonian and South American-themed zoo spanning secluded woodland, home to over 200 animals and birds.
- RNLI Henry Blogg Museum**
Celebrating the life of the most decorated lifeboatman in RNLI history, who with his crew, saved over 873 lives from the North Sea.
- Cromer**
A beautiful Victorian seaside town renowned for sandy beaches, an iconic pier and famous Cromer crab. With dramatic clifftop views, a working fishing industry and thriving local community.
- Sheringham**
A vibrant seaside town renowned for its award-winning Blue Flag sandy beach, heritage steam railway and rich fishing heritage.
- Wells-next-the-Sea**
Within a National Landscape is one of the coast's most attractive towns, home to a bustling harbour, long sandy beach and iconic stilted beach huts.

Walk

The Norfolk coastal path is on the doorstep with easy accessible routes via Cromer and beyond to the east and Sheringham along to Wells and Holkham to the West.

The National Landscape along the coastline includes some beautiful seaside villages full of independent shops and local cafés.

Salthouse Marsh up to Cley, there are many wildlife habitats and places to visit including the seals at Blakeney Point.

Sheringham Park and local gardens give nature lovers plenty of choice inland too.

Cycle

Bikes can be hired in Cromer and Sheringham.

From Cromer join National Cycle Network route 30: a circular loop through Great Yarmouth or cycle along the country lanes in the local area.

- ✓ Barrier fob issued on arrival
- ✓ Single access road to enter and leave site

- ✓ Code operated door locks, including for the accessible room

- ✓ TV reception – poor. Aerial recommended
- ✓ Club Wi-Fi. Premium wifi – charges apply. Free wifi to the pitch

Emergency out of hours contact information can be found on the reception door/window, in the information room and on the facilities notice board.

- ✓ Machines are token operated only. Tokens are available from reception at £1.25 each. All washing machine cycles are £5, pre-wash is £1.25 and a 15 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1.25
