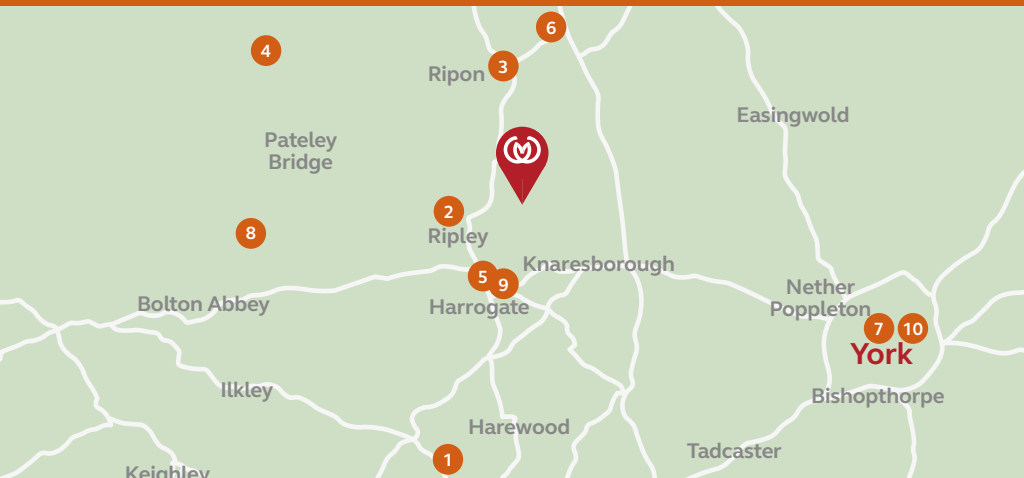

Things to do

- 1 Golden Acre Park**
A park renowned for its flat circular lakeside walk, mature woodlands and themed gardens. Accessible and free – perfect for families, walkers and nature enthusiasts.
- 2 Ripley Castle**
A Grade I listed stately home offering visitors medieval and Gothic Revival architecture alongside stunning, expansive grounds.
- 3 Ripon Courthouse Museum**
A remarkably preserved 1830s Georgian courtroom that immerses the realities of Victorian justice. Stand in the dock, sit in the judge's seat and explore the Liberty of Ripon.
- 4 Lost Earth Adventures**
Try abseiling, rock climbing, gorge walking, ghyll scrambling, mountain biking, caving or hiking with friendly, qualified guides across different sites.
- 5 Spirit of Harrogate**
Immersive tastings from the producers of the award-winning Slingsby Gin, who craft using pure spring water from the Harrogate aquifer and local botanicals.
- 6 The Big Shoot – Thirsk**
Everyone can enjoy the hilariously fun and competitive thrills of Clay Pigeon Shooting.
- 7 National Archery – York**
Master the ancient art of Archery at one of the national shooting ranges. The perfect activity for all ages and athletic abilities and great fun!
- 8 Yorkshire Dales National Park**
A protected national park famous for its rolling hills, deep valleys, spectacular limestone scenery, heather-carpeted moorlands and traditional stone-built villages.
- 9 Harrogate**
An elegant, affluent spa town famous for its historic Montpellier Quarter, the Stray parkland and Turkish Baths. At its heart lies the iconic Bettys Café Tea Rooms.
- 10 York**
A picturesque, walled cathedral city with a rich 2,000 year history of Roman roots, Viking heritage and medieval charm. Famous for its pedestrianised cobblestone streets, Gothic architecture and museums.

Walk

There are several footpaths in the local area including the Abbey Road Wood Sculptures and Knarborough Castle walk, a 3 mile route from the centre of town to the castle, via a trail of fascinating wood sculptures.

Starting at the riverside car park, you can take various length circular walks by the River Nidd, ideal for families, strollers, amblers or serious hikers.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 67, York to Harrogate. From Knarborough to Ripley on a largely traffic-free path. The route is a 10 mile ride with refreshments available at Ripley.
