Things to do

1 Longleat Safari Park

The UK's first drive-through safari experience. It features a multi-mile safari with lions, tigers and wolves, alongside boat safaris, walking areas and the historic Elizabethan Longleat House.

2 Stourhead House

A renowned 18th Century Palladian-style villa within world-famous landscape gardens, featuring a Neo-classical interior, extensive art collections and a unique library.

3 The Roman Baths

A world-renowned preserved public bathing complex built around 70 AD, featuring Britain's only natural hot springs. This UNESCO World Heritage Site served as a sacred, social and wellness hub where Romans worshipped Sulis Minerva.

4 Stonehenge

The best known prehistoric monument in Europe – a massive outer circle and inner horseshoe of standing stones.

5 Caving and Climbing

Cheddar Gorge provides world-class, thrilling limestone climbing and accessible caving, including adventure caving. A premier UK climbing destination with 300+ routes and famous show caves.

6 East Somerset Railway

A heritage steam railway operating as a charity-run tourist attraction since 1974. It runs along a former GWR branch line through the Mendip countryside.

7 Wells

Named after local springs and England's smallest city renowned for its rich medieval heritage, stunning Gothic cathedral and the moated Bishop's Palace.

8 Bath

Known for its natural hot springs and honey-coloured Georgian architecture, the city combines contemporary culture with rich history, overflowing with popular attractions.

Walk

There are scenic walks from the site through woodland to the local pubs. Popular routes include the Heaven's Gate circular walk, and the Shearwater Lake route for estate views, trails around the woodland-dense Longleat Woods and walks through Horningsham village.

There is no access through the Estate without a day ticket.

Cycle

Cycling around the Longleat Estate offers scenic routes through ancient woodlands, rolling hills and past the historic house and safari park.

The estate grants access for cyclists, primarily through National Cycle Network routes 24 and 25, which allow riders to pass through the grounds.

Site access restrictions:

- ✓ Barrier fob issued on arrival

Accessing the facilities

Facility access restrictions:

- ✓ Radar key door lock on the accessible room
- ✓ Code operated door locks on the baby and toddler bathrooms

Connectivity

- ✓ Mobile phone signal – intermittent to poor. Mobile phone signal may vary depending on network provider
- ✓ TV reception – poor (Booster system available on bollard but 25 metre aerial coaxial cable required)
- ✓ Club Wi-Fi. Free wifi to the pitch

In an emergency

Emergency out of hours information can be found on the reception door/window and in the information room.

Laundry facilities

- ✓ Washing machines are operated by contactless debit or credit card only. Cycles are £5
- ✓ Tumble dryers are token operated only. Tokens are available from reception at £1.25 each. A 15 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1.25

- ✓ Dog walks from the site (on lead)
