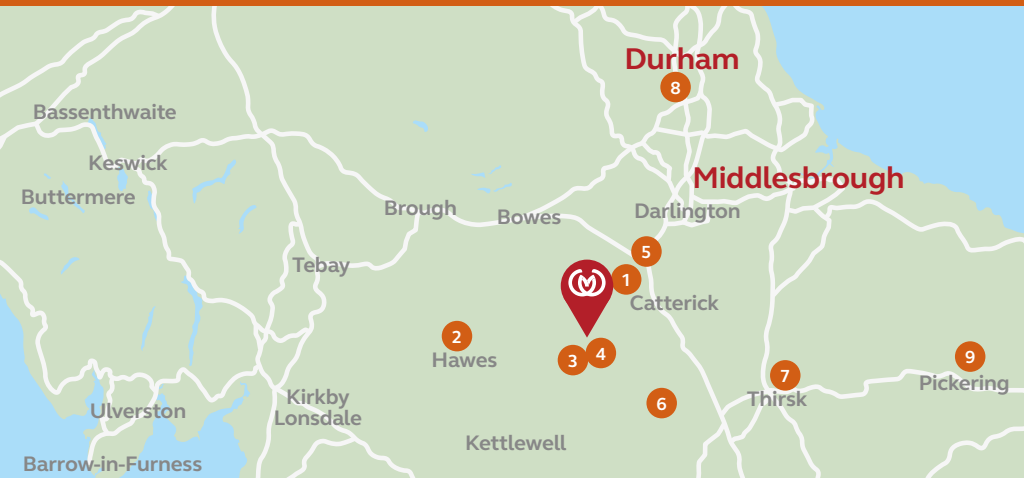

Things to do

1 Richmond Castle

One of England's best-preserved and oldest Norman fortresses, situated high on a cliff above the River Swale. Featuring a stone keep, the historic Scolland's Hall and views of the Yorkshire Dales.

2 Wensleydale Creamery

This artisan cheesemaker, famous for hand-crafting the iconic, creamy and crumbly Yorkshire Wensleydale cheese – the creamery pairs 1,000 years of heritage with modern, innovative blends.

3 The Forbidden Corner

A folly garden located in the Tuppill Park Estate, open to the public. The garden is designed as a maze, with tunnels, grottoes and sculptures.

4 Middleham Castle

A striking medieval fortress renowned as the childhood home of King Richard III. Its defining feature is one of the largest Norman keeps in England and stands today as an extensive, roofless ruin.

5 Go Ballistic – Scotch Corner

Experience blood pumping exhilaration and eliminate the enemy in a paintball adventure.

6 Black Sheep Brewery

Priding itself on a rebellious blending of traditional brewing with modern craft to produce award-winning cask ales and craft beers. Offering tours of the brewing process, concluding with a tasting.

7 Thirsk

A charming, traditional market town famous for its cobbled market square, racecourse and as the home of the author and vet James Herriot.

8 Durham

A picturesque city famous for its dramatic hilltop peninsula defined by the River Wear. A renowned UNESCO Site, Durham Cathedral and Durham Castle and is home to a university.

9 Pickering

A busy market town offering a blend of history, heritage, local culture and countryside charm – the gateway to the North York Moors National Park.

Walk

The Yorkshire Dales National Park is in easy reach, with walking routes for all abilities. Take a 2.2 mile walk from the Aysgarth Falls National Park Centre to Low, Middle and High Force which make up the triple cascade of Aysgarth Falls.

Cycle

Hire electric, mountain or road bikes to explore the stunning Yorkshire Dales.

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 71: part of the Sea-to-Sea trail, a road route that passes through Leyburn.
