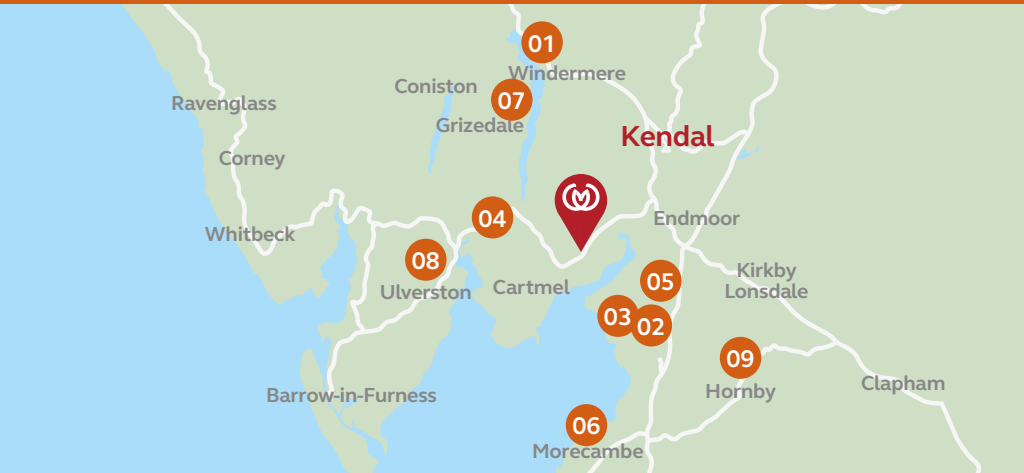

1 The Lake District

2 Leighton Hall

Grade II listed building, breathtaking garden, parkland and network of footpaths.

3 RSPB Leighton Moss

Discover the trails and get closer to the wildlife with birds, bugs, bats, otters and red deer.

4 Lakeside and Haverthwaite Railway

Travel back in time and enjoy views from your carriage.

5 The Lakeland Wildlife Oasis

Meet your favourite animals through the 'Animal Encounters' experience or become a zookeeper for a day!

6 Jump Rush Trampoline Park

Jump Rush is the ultimate trampoline park in Morecambe and much more!

7 Hill Top Farm

Step back in time with a visit to Hill Top Farm – a must for Beatrix Potter lovers!

8 Ulverston

Lined with cobbled streets, this market town is the start of the 70 mile Cumbrian Way. It is also the birthplace of Stan Laurel, and home to the world's only Laurel and Hardy Museum.

9 Cartmel

A beautiful lakeland village with an 800 year old priory. Popular with foodies for its excellent restaurants, famous cheese shop and the original Sticky Toffee Pudding shop.

Walk

The 70 mile Cumbrian Way passes near the site linking Ulverston and Carlisle. There is also the Cumbria Coastal Path. Walk to Grange-over-Sands, three miles from site.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route is route number 7, Walney to Wear, located right outside of site.
