



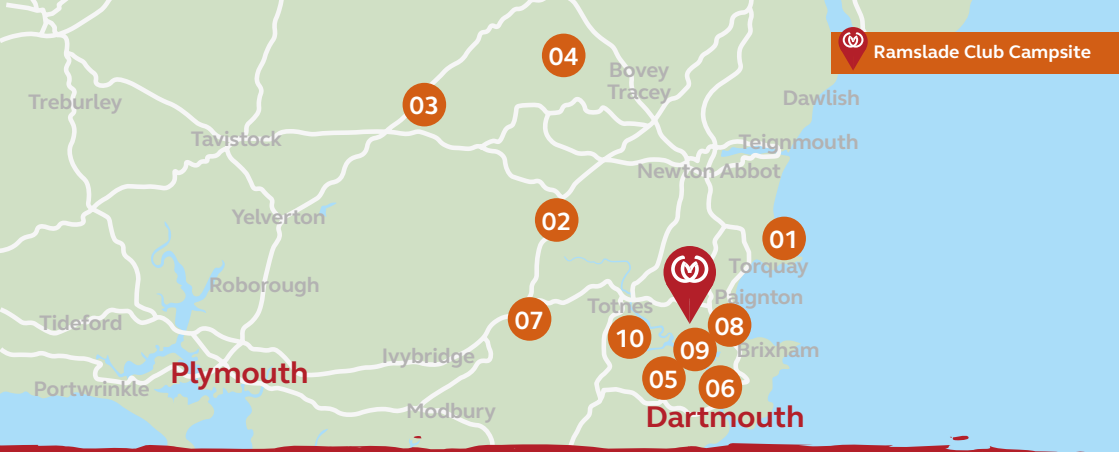

# Make the most of your time

## Visit

- 1 Kents Cavern Prehistoric Caves**  
The most important prehistoric cave in Britain with artefacts dating back over 500,000 years.
- 2 South Devon Railway**  
Former Great Western Railway line, runs from Buckfastleigh to Totnes.
- 3 Dartmoor National Park**  
The largest and wildest area of open country in Southern England. Visit Becky Falls, voted Devon's Top Beauty Spot and one of the World Wildlife Fund's Incredible Family Days.

- 4 Go Falconry**  
Come into close proximity with some of the world's most elegant and beautiful birds of prey.
- 5 Sea Kayak Devon**  
Explore the unique environment where the sea meets the cliffs and rocks of Devon's coast. Big double kayaks are available for families so that children as young as 5 can join in the fun!

The Dart Valley cycle track at Totnes is 5 miles away.

### 8 Paignton Zoo

With over 2,500 animals you're in for a wild time at Paignton Zoo.

### 9 Greenway

The National Trust's Greenway is the holiday home of author Agatha Christie and her family.

### 10 Round Robin Boat & Steam Train

This award-winning tour includes a steam train, river boat and bus visiting the quaint towns of Paignton, Dartmouth and Totnes.





## Visitor's top tips

**||** Just a stone's throw from the picturesque village of Stoke Gabriel, fabulous for crabbing!

Take a river trip to Dartmouth or Brixham and enjoy the seawater-filled (and free!) Lido.

Visit Hunts Cider Farm nearby, for excellent home-made cider.

If you have dogs visit Cockington Country Park or Meadfoot Beach, or Goodrington has a dog friendly part of the beach too.

There are three National Trust properties within 7 miles of site.

Very pleasant walk into Stoke Gabriel which is a very pretty village at the side of the estuary. A longer walk will take you into quirky Totnes.

Go crabbing by the Rivershack Cafe which is only a short walk from site. Don't forget your crab line! The Rivershack cafe is lovely for a drink.

The Church House Inn is very characterful with tasty home-made food and a good selection of local ales and ciders.

Try the mobile food vans that visit site, the fish and chip van in particular! **||**

## Close by

### Supermarkets

Sainsburys is 1.3 miles away and Asda is 1.5 miles from site.

### Cinema

In Paignton, 5 miles from site.

### Swimming pool

Paignton, about 5 miles.

### Tourist Information

Paignton, about 5 miles.

### Public transport

There is a bus outside the site exit, which runs from Stoke Gabriel to Paignton.

### Petrol station

Sainsburys is 1.3 miles away and Shell is 3.3 miles from site.

### Nearest cashpoint

There is a cashpoint at Sainsburys, 1.3 miles away or at Asda 1.5 miles from site.
