Things to do

1 Arundel Castle

A restored and remodelled medieval castle built in 1067 to guard the River Arun. Featuring gothic Victorian architecture, opulent rooms with rare art and 40 acres of gardens.

2 Denbies Wine Estate

England's largest single estate vineyard and a leading wine producer – a fascinating insight into the world of wine production.

3 RSPB Pulborough Brooks

A wetland nature reserve of diverse habitats for breeding nightingales in spring, dragonflies in summer and thousands of wintering wildfowl.

4 Petworth House and Park

A magnificent 17th Century Mansion displaying one of the finest art collections in the UK.

5 Chichester

A cultural hub and popular destination with Roman walls, a 12th Century cathedral and a vibrant arts scene, there are pedestrianised streets, the Chichester Festival Theatre and the Novium Museum.

6 Go Ape – Crawley

An outdoor adventure playground with high-ropes courses, ziplines, Tarzan Swings and forest activities in the woodland treetops.

7 Southwater Country Park

A scenic nature-focused recreational site with 3 lakes, a sandy beach and the popular Dinosaur Island adventure playground.

8 Guildford

A historic, affluent riverside town known for its cobbled High Street, Norman castle ruins, a modern cathedral and scenic access to the Surrey Hills.

9 Brighton

This diverse, bohemian seaside city is steeped in vibrant charm and culture. Famed for its pebble beach, iconic Brighton Palace Pier and the exotic Royal Pavilion.

10 Lewes

Dotted with boutique shops and antique centres, this historic town has Lewes Castle, Anne of Cleves House and the Harvey's Brewery.

Walk

Join the South Downs Way which runs between Winchester and Eastbourne through the South Downs National Park.

The High Weald Landscape Trail is a 90 mile route through the National Landscape starting at Horsham station and linking the villages and historic gardens for which the area is famous.

Cycle

Follow the Downs Link which runs past the site following an old railway line joining the South to the North Downs.
