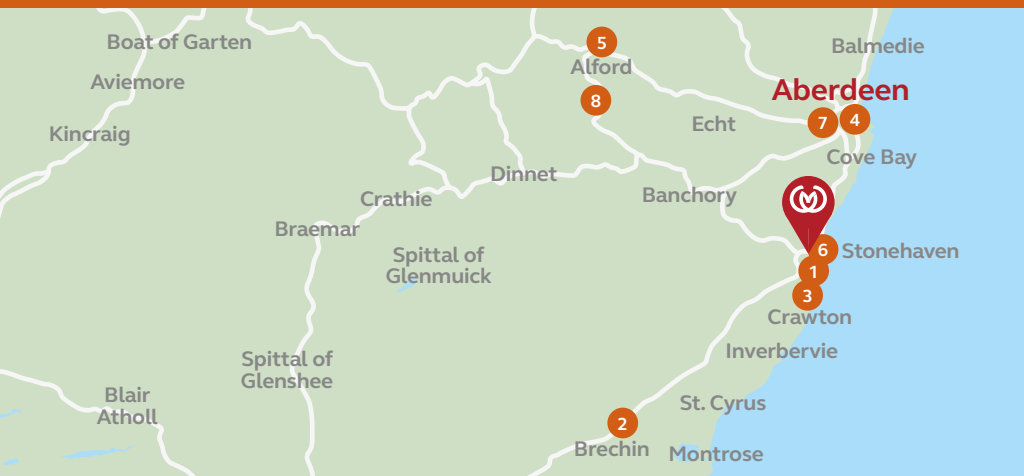


Stonehaven Queen Elizabeth Park Club Campsite

Things to do

- 1 Dunnottar Castle**
A spectacular ruined fortress towering on a rocky headland above the North Sea. Famous for its romantic appearance often featured in films and a rich history, including hiding the Scottish Crown Jewels.
- 2 Caledonian Railway**
A major 19th Century Scottish railway, famous for using bright blue locomotives. Today one of the most visited tourist attractions in Angus providing beautiful journeys through the countryside.
- 3 RSPB Fowlsheugh Reserve**
A coastal nature reserve famous for hosting one of the largest seabird colonies on mainland Britain. Up to 130,000 birds, including guillemots, razorbills, kittiwakes and puffins.
- 4 Aberdeen Maritime Museum**
Located on the historic Shiprow, the museum explores the city's deep-rooted connection to the sea, covering shipbuilding, fishing and the North Sea oil industry.
- 5 Grampian Transport Museum**
An award-winning charity museum showcasing the history of travel – displaying items from 1800s horse-drawn carriages to modern supercars, with interactive exhibits.
- 6 Stand-up Paddleboarding**
Paddle below the iconic Dunnottar Castle, explore majestic caves and coves and look out for wildlife on a fun paddleboarding excursion.
- 7 Aberdeen**
A prominent port city known as the 'Granite City' for its distinctive grey stone buildings that sparkle in the sun. Serving as the energy capital of Europe with a rich maritime history, including a resident pod of dolphins!
- 8 Craigievar Castle**
A stunning pink-harled tower house often cited as an inspiration for Disney's Cinderella Castle – this well-preserved, fairytale castle features turrets, corbelling and a distinctive pink wash.

Walk

Discover the stories behind the landmarks with Scot Free Tours – featuring tales of religious discord, the Titanic and birthplace of the deep fried Mars bar! The Coastal Path is outside the site entrance and there are scenic beach walks to the cliffs of Dunnottar Castle.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 1: Coast and Castles North – Edinburgh to Aberdeen. And there are many other routes in the countryside.

Emergency out of hours contact information can be found on the reception door/window and in the information room.
