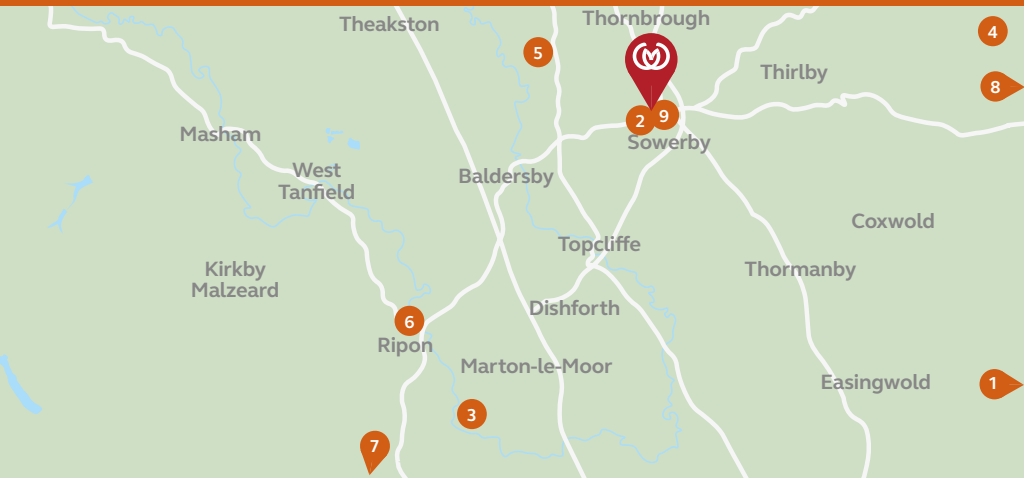

Things to do

- 1 Castle Howard**
A magnificent 18th Century Baroque stately home renowned for its iconic central dome, opulent interiors and status as the filming location for *Brideshead Revisited*.
- 2 Thirsk Museum**
A charming museum displaying the history of Thirsk, at the birthplace of one its most famous residents, Thomas Lord, founder of Lord's Cricket Ground.
- 3 Newby Hall**
A Grade I listed Georgian country house famed as one of the finest 'Robert Adam Houses' – exquisite interiors, Chippendale furniture and collection of Roman sculpture.
- 4 Rievaulx Abbey**
One of England's most powerful Cistercian monasteries, the ruins offer a glimpse into medieval monastic life, architectural grandeur and the abbey's rise and fall.
- 5 Thirsk Birds of Prey Centre**
Home to 100 birds from 50 species, including owls, vultures, eagles and kites. Enjoy demonstrations with skilled handlers and up-close viewing.
- 6 Ripon**
A beautiful cathedral city steeped in history which is woven into its charming streets, alongside quirky shops, cafés and galleries.
- 7 Harrogate**
An elegant, affluent spa town famous for its historic Montpellier Quarter, the Stray parkland and Turkish Baths. At its heart lies the iconic Bettys Café Tea Rooms.
- 8 Pickering**
A busy market town offering a blend of history, heritage, local culture and countryside charm – the gateway to the North York Moors National Park.
- 9 The World of James Herriot**
A museum housed in the original home and veterinary surgery of the real James Herriot – stepping into the setting that inspired *All Creatures Great and Small*.

Walk

It's a five minute walk into the centre of Thirsk. Also enjoy a stroll along the River Cod Beck.

This site is a perfect base to explore both the Yorkshire Dales and North York Moors National Parks.

Cycle

Explore the edges of the North York Moors National Park on National Cycle Route 65.

Another nearby National Cycle Network route is 657: Thirsk to Easingwold.
