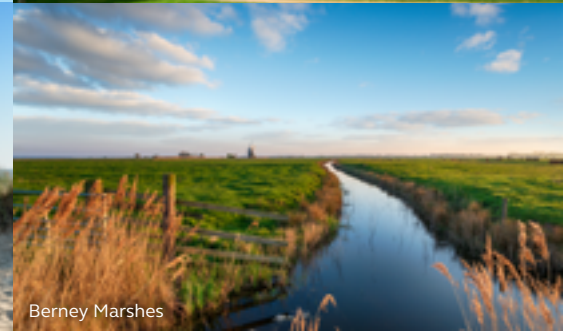

Things to do

- 1 Pleasurewood Hills**
Family-friendly theme park with rides, including the Wipeout rollercoaster and soft play areas – a great value, shorter-queue park alternative.
- 2 Fairhaven Woodland**
A 130-acre haven combining woodland with a private Broad and miles of accessible pathways, wildlife and year-round seasonal colour.
- 3 Africa Alive!**
UK's largest and most exciting wildlife attraction, home to animals from Africa in spectacular mixed and open habitats, including rhino, lions, giraffes, buffalo and zebra.
- 4 RSPB Berney Marshes and Breydon Water**
A remote, untouched nature reserve famous for expansive grazing marshes and tens of thousands of migratory birds.
- 5 Wild Swimming**
A serene, open-water experience within a 2 mile freshwater lake renowned for tranquil, cold, clear waters and floating sauna.
- 6 The Broads National Park**
Britain's largest protected wetland and inland boating destination. Featuring over miles of navigable rivers and lakes set in wide, open skies.
- 7 Canoe Trails**
Explore the rivers and waterways of the Park and River Wensum. Suitable for all ages, ranging from short city paddles to overnight wilderness adventures.
- 8 Lowestoft**
A traditional seaside resort and Britain's most easterly town. With Blue Flag-awarded beaches, piers, maritime history and a focus on renewable energy.
- 9 Norwich**
A vibrant city in touch with today's world, but steeped in history and overflowing with culture with the River Wensum at its heart.
- 10 Great Yarmouth**
A premier seaside resort offering 15 miles of sandy beaches, the famous 'Golden Mile' seafront with amusement arcades and Sea Life Centre and rich maritime heritage.

Walk

The 50 mile Suffolk coastal path is easily accessible from site.

Both Lowestoft and Southwold beach walks can be reached by foot.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 1: Felixstowe to Boston.

There are electric poles and deep water adjacent to, but off site – safely fenced.

Beach side pitches are 'Non-Awning' only (*Local restrictions include: No pop-up tents, flags, windbreaks, dog pens etc. Sun canopies must be in by 8pm and not left out while the unit is unattended due to strong winds*).
