- 1 Raby Castle**
Enjoy a family day out at this well preserved castle with deer park and gardens.
- 2 Captain Cook Experience**
Climb on board a replica of Captain Cook's ship and sail around Whitby.
- 3 Hartlepool Royal Navy Museum**
A superb recreation of an 18th century seaport and home of HMS Trincomalee.
- 4 Richmond Castle**
One of the oldest Norman fortresses in Britain, with breathtaking views of The Dales.
- 5 White water course**
Enjoy white water rafting, canoeing, paddleboarding, power boat trips and raft building.
- 6 Air Trail**
High ropes adventure with an exciting assortment of rope bridges, tight ropes, cargo nets and swinging stepping stones.
- 7 North Yorkshire Moors Railway**
Step back in time on the heritage steam railway, passing through the stunning Moors scenery.
- 8 Durham**
Historic riverside city with cobbled streets and world famous cathedral.
- 9 North Yorkshire Moors**
One of the largest expanses of heather moorland in the UK, a must see for walkers.
- 10 Redcar**
Seaside resort home to the worlds oldest surviving lifeboat.

Walk

Enjoy walks between Stockton and Middlesbrough along the River Tees. Woodland and lakeside walks can be enjoyed in the grounds surrounding this Jacobean house.

Cycle

Tees Barrage is a 10 mile circular route starting from Tees Barrage, passing Portrack Marshes Nature Reserve and the Transporter Bridge.

The nearest route to this site is 6, Derby to York.
