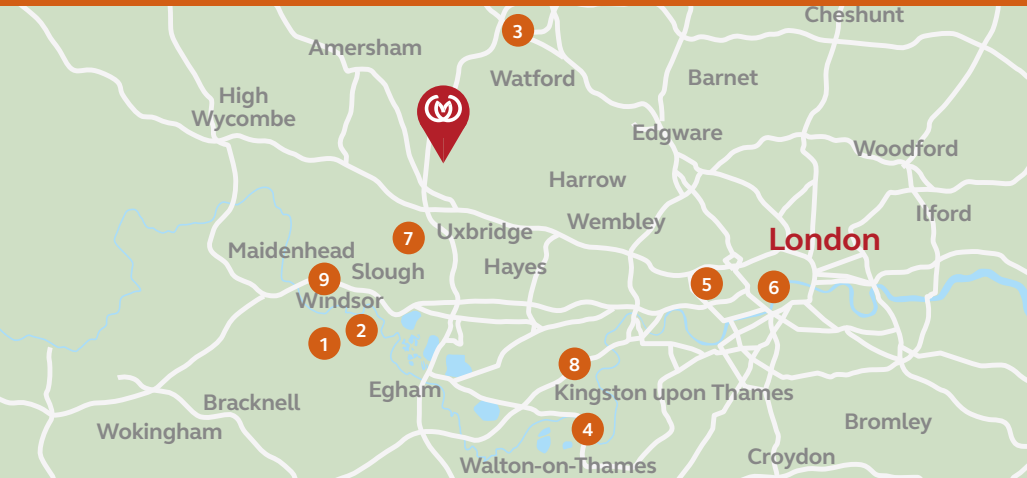

Things to do

1 Legoland Windsor

A UK theme park for families with children aged 2-12. Set across 150 acres, featuring over 55 rides, live shows and building experiences centered around the lego brick.

2 Windsor Castle

The oldest and largest occupied castle in the world. It functions as both a primary royal residence for His Majesty The King and an active working palace.

3 Warner Bros. Studio Tour

A permanent, behind-the-scenes walking exhibit, where all Harry Potter films were produced. It features authentic sets, original costumes and genuine props.

4 Hampton Court Palace

A spectacular royal palace built by Cardinal Wolsey in 1514 and expanded by Henry VIII, blending Tudor and Baroque architecture.

5 Sambourne House

A remarkably well-preserved Victorian townhouse. Formerly the home of famed *Punch* magazine illustrator Edward Linley Sambourne.

6 The London Eye

A 135 metre-tall cantilevered observation wheel on the River Thames. With 32 glass capsules, it rotates continuously at a walking pace to offer 360-degree views.

7 Go Ape – Slough

This self-paced adventure combines ziplines, obstacle course rope crossings and Tarzan Swings, set above the ground in the forest canopy.

8 Bushy Park

A 1,000+ acre haven, the second-largest of London's Royal Parks. Famous for its roaming herds of wild red and fallow deer, woodland gardens and flat landscapes.

9 Windsor

A historic market town most famous for Windsor Castle. A fashionable and sophisticated area hosting world events, rich in things to see and do with walks, tours, boat trips, gardens and famous racecourses.

Walk

Walk around the Denham Lakes and the Grand Union Canal. Or take a walk around Northmoor Hill Wood. Access the woodland walks direct from site.

Cycle

Cycling is suggested on the Colne Valley Trail – this is shared with walkers and horse riders.

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 6: Greenwich to Keswick.
